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What rate applies to what

Every 4-digit tariff heading, sorted into its GST slab. Rates follow CBIC Notification 9/2025-Central Tax (Rate), issued 2025-09-17 and effective 2025-09-22 — the GST 2.0 structure that replaced the old 12% and 28% slabs for most goods.

This is a browsing document, organised by rate. If instead you know the product and want its code, the full 21,703-code list is at gstextract.com/hsn-code-lookup.

It is real text — Ctrl+F (Cmd+F on a Mac) finds a heading or a product word instantly.

Slabs at a glance

Exempt / Nil rated — 92 headings. No GST charged. Input tax credit on inputs used for these supplies is not available.

0.25% — 3 headings. Schedule V — rough diamonds and similar precious stones.

3% — 15 headings. Schedule IV — gold, silver, platinum and articles of precious metal.

5% — 626 headings. The largest slab after GST 2.0 — most food, essentials and mass-consumption goods.

18% — 534 headings. The standard slab — most manufactured goods, electronics and industrial items.

28% — 3 headings. Largely emptied by GST 2.0; a handful of entries remain in the dataset.

40% — 3 headings. The GST 2.0 demerit slab — sin and luxury goods, replacing 28% + cess for these items.

Outside GST — 6 headings. Alcoholic liquor for human consumption sits outside GST altogether under Article 366(12A) — taxed by state excise, with no GST rate to quote. Listing it as exempt or nil-rated, as many rate lists do, is wrong.

Two things worth knowing before you use a rate

1. A heading can contain sub-codes at different rates. 20 of the 1,283 headings here do. They are marked 'varies' in the list and collected in their own section at the end — for those, the 8-digit code decides the rate, not the heading. Most published rate lists silently pick one.

2. The notification does not name every heading individually; where it does not, the rate shown is inherited from the chapter. That is how classification works and is usually right, but for a high-value or disputed item, check the notification itself or ask your consultant before you invoice.
